

They are an independent group of global leaders working for peace, justice, human rights and a sustainable planet. Please join me in signing The Elders' letter to global leaders.

Despite the urgency of the multiple crises our world is facing, there is a dangerous lack of cooperation and accountability among leaders. We need an urgent change of direction in global decision-making, with a bold new approach rooted in justice and dignity. We need 'long-view leadership.'

Last month, on the eve of the Munich Security
Conference, The Elders published an <u>open letter</u> in partnership with the <u>Future of Life Institute</u>. Together, we called for long-view leadership

from decision-makers who understand the urgency of the existential threats we face, and believe in our ability to overcome them. This letter was co-signed by over 150 former leaders, Nobel Laureates, scientists, philanthropists, campaigners, activists, artists, and public commentators, demonstrating the strength of our shared concern.






# Everyday Ubuntu by Mungi Ngomane (Desmond Tutu's Granddaughter)


